SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication and Social Welfare reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for *Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration [Public Entity to select as appropriate]*;
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be **30 days** from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) **Have a valid certified company Registration Certificate.**
- (b) **Have an original valid Good Standing Tax Certificate; or A valid certified copy of an original document, as certified by the Namibian Police or by a Commissioner of Oaths.**
- (c) **Have an original valid Good Standing Social Security Certificate or A valid certified copy of an original document, as certified by the Namibian Police or by a Commissioner of Oaths.**
- (d) **Have a certified Copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that the bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998; certified by the Namibian Police or by a Commissioners of Oath have a written undertaking as contemplated in section 138 (2) of the Labour Act, 2007.**
- (e) **Have a certificate indicating SME status (applicable to SMEs only).**
- (f) **A bidder shall not be awarded more than one lot. Preference may be given to bidders operating in the particular Region where the goods are required.**
- (g) **Have a certified copy of a fitness certificate from a local authority within the particular Region where the goods are required.**
- (h) **All pages must be initialled.**
- (i) **The bidder shall provide a performance guarantee equivalent to the bid amount.**

NB: Kindly do not charge VAT if you are not VAT registered.

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to submit a **Bid Securing Declaration** for this procurement process.

6. Delivery

Delivery shall be within 30 days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period **shall not be considered**.

6.1. The following tests and inspections will be conducted on the goods at delivery:

- **Substandard products, right products and correct quantities etc.**

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication and Social Welfare (Head Office), not later than 10 May 2023 17H00. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach the Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication and Social Welfare, Ground Floor Reception, Northern Tower, not later than the same date by the same date and time. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the **Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication and Social Welfare** and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

11. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to **Ministry of Gender Equality, Poverty Eradication and Social Welfare** requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

12. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.
